



Celebrating excellence: the CFE National Honour Roll

The CPA Board of Evaluators recognizes the top Common Final Examination (CFE) writers in Canada by naming a National Honour Roll. Four gold medallists are identified from across Canada—one from each of the CPA Western School of Business, CPA Ontario, CPA Quebec, and the CPA Atlantic School of Business.

The candidate with the highest standing in Canada on the CFE receives the Governor General's Gold Medal and a cash prize of \$5,000. The three other regional gold medallists each receive a cash prize of \$2,500.
